Today is First Sunday of Lent, four days after Ash Wednesday.

Is fasting still relevant today? Or is it completely outdated? I believe that each of us benefits from stepping away from our daily routine, making a change— whether in ourselves, at home, or wherever it may be. In a similar way, the time leading up to Easter should be for us—a time of calm, of stepping lightly, of pausing, and of preparing for the greatest feast: the Resurrection. Fasting can take many forms; we can fast with all our senses:

Fasting with our eyes:

Fasting from computers and television, instead taking in the awakening nature around us, focusing less on ourselves and more on others.

Fasting with our ears:

Refraining from constant loud music and noise, instead listening to the softer tones, paying attention to what others are telling us, hearing the voice within—do we hear God?

Fasting with our mouth:

Abstaining from excessive indulgence, reducing unhealthy habits, instead embracing a healthier lifestyle, treating nature's gifts with care and sustainability.

Fasting with our hands:

Avoiding rushed and frantic actions, instead taking more time, letting our hands rest, eliminating unnecessary activities, and using our hands to help instead.

Fasting with our feet:

Reducing constant movement and busyness, instead allowing ourselves and our families more peace, perhaps finally making long-overdue visits.

You may think of many other things you can consciously do or refrain from doing in the coming weeks leading up to Easter. Perhaps you will also take advantage of the offerings from our churches, which can enrich this time for you and provide a moment of retreat.
